JAMESTOWN'S HISTORY AT RISK OF BEING LOST FOREVER

For centuries, visitors to Jamestown heard the story that the site of the original 1607 James Fort had eroded into the James River and was lost forever. In 1994 Dr. William Kelso led archaeologists to disprove this theory and began excavations on the island. Kelso's pioneering work in disproving the belief that the original James Fort had eroded away into the James River paved the way for decades of excavation and discovery. Within two years, they found evidence proving most of the fort remained buried on dry land. After three decades of continuous work, archaeologists have unearthed an

Jamestown served as the colony's capital until 1699, a period of occupation that has been minimally investigated and the loss of this evidence would be significant. Archaeologists are using Ground Penetrating Radar (GPR) to complete geophysical surveys of the property and to identify known and unknown subsurface artifacts and features.

The threat posed by a rapidly changing environment, particularly the risk of flooding in areas like Smith's Field, underscores the urgency of continued archaeological research and conservation efforts. The potential loss of evidence from this later period of occupation, which has been minimally investigated thus far, emphasizes the significance of protecting and studying every aspect of Jamestown's history.

Each major weather event increases the likelihood of irreversible damage to Jamestown's priceless archaeological resources. The next five years are critical. If we miss this window, the efforts to save the site [Smith's Field] will become increasingly difficult. Without intervention, the loss of our collective heritage as Americans will be devastating.

unparalleled collection of over four million artifacts and features that shed light on the lives of our ancestors. Today, that history is threatened by a rapidly changing environment.

Areas which have not yet been excavated, such as low-lying Smith's Field on the west side of the fort is at a higher risk of flooding. This field dates to the later 17th century when

Captain John Smith, who in 1607 helped establish the first English settlement at Jamestown, drilled his troops in this field, thus its name. The settlement began with the Fort and soon spread. The western expansion began at Smith's Field and developed into a 40-60 acre town, that is being encroached by flood waters. A previous 3-D survey software identified priority excavation sites.

Archaeology provides valuable insights into the lives, behaviors, and activities of past people. Through the analysis of artifacts, architecture, and other remains, archaeologists reconstruct past societies, economies, technologies, belief systems, and cultural practices, contributing to a richer understanding of our ancestor's history. Archaeology often fills gaps in historical records or provides complementary information to written sources.

Trials and Tribulations REINTERPRETING 17TH CENTURY WOMEN'S HISTORY AT JAMESTOWN

Gifts to the William M. Kelso Archaeology Fund will also allow educational staff to conduct further archival and historical research, create interpretive materials and educational aids, and update program scripts to enhance women's history programs at Jamestown.

The effort to reinterpret 17th-century women's history at Jamestown offers a compelling opportunity to explore the diverse experiences and contributions of women during this pivotal period. By utilizing real artifacts excavated from Jamestown and held within archaeological collections, researchers like Dr. Amy Stallings (Ph. D. Early American History) can provide tangible entry points into women's ordinary and extraordinary lives.

The identified themes for further exploration highlight the multifaceted roles that women played in early colonial society:

Nurturing Growth, Women and Horticulture: Joan Pierce's story exemplifies women's roles in sustaining households

through horticulture, even during periods of hardship like the Starving Time. Her ability to cultivate a substantial garden speaks to the resilience and resourcefulness of women in providing for their families.

Claiming Property, Women as Landowners: Sarah Drummond's ownership of land in her own name challenges traditional narratives of women's dependency on male relatives for property rights. Her insistence on reclaiming her family farm after its confiscation during Bacon's Rebellion underscores women's agency in asserting their ownership and rights in colonial society.

Negotiating Partnership, Women and Marriage: Cecily Baley Jordan's scandalous engagement to two men simultaneously sheds light on the complexities of women's experiences in navigating relationships and societal expectations. Her struggle with a religious crisis reflects the challenges faced by women in reconciling personal desires with societal norms.

Pursuing Justice, Women and the Courts: Elizabeth Key's legal battle for freedom as a biracial indentured servant highlights the complexity of gender, race, and legal status in colonial America. Her successful lawsuit against attempts to enslave her underscores the resilience and agency of marginalized women in seeking justice.

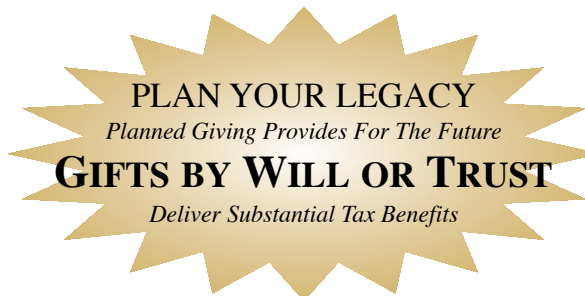
